The Brain Injury Association of Georgia, in partnership with Camp Twin Lakes, hosted a camp for survivors and caregivers!

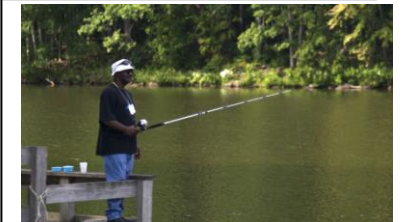
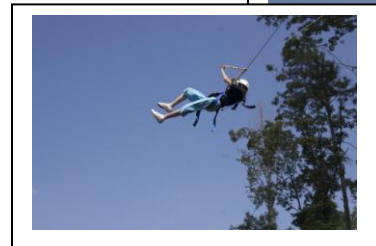
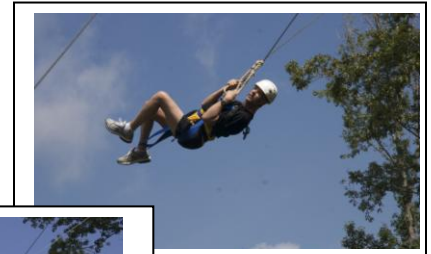
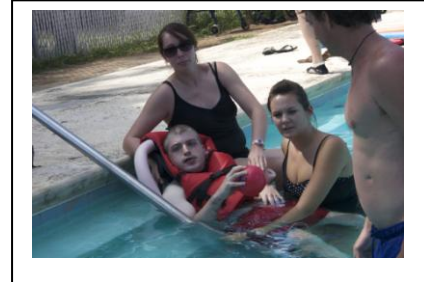
